



The University of Guadalajara (UDG) is pleased to announce the offering of partial grants for its new  
“International English Teaching Program”

## Objectives of the program

- To enable international students to have the opportunity to practice their English teaching skills in a context in which English is taught as foreign language.
- To expose international students to the Mexican culture and hence raise intercultural awareness.
- To enrich English Language teaching practices at the University of Guadalajara.
- To promote and reinforce the study of English as a foreign Language in the University's network.

## Course duration:

One academic calendar from mid-August to mid December 2014.

## The partial grant Includes For each recipient:

- Housing appointed by the host institution.
- Scholarship for \$20,000 MXN for the whole course duration.
- Air fare fee (\$15,000 MXN).

## The grant does not include

- Health insurance with international coverage.
- Local transportation.
- Meals.
- Others.

## IETP Candidates

### Eligible candidates are:

- Undergraduate or graduate American Students majoring in TESOL, ESOL, Spanish or Applied Linguistics.

*\*Prior language teaching experience is not necessary but will be a plus.*

*\*Spanish proficiency is not required.*

## IETP Activities

Selected candidates will be appointed to one of the Campuses that comprise the University's network structure.

### The IETP activities will consist of:

- Planning and teaching advanced English Language courses such as academic reading, writing and speaking (English for Specific Purposes).
- Candidates will be asked to render approximately 8 hours of weekly service in the Self-Access Centers (workshops and tutorial) and 12 hours of weekly teaching practice in a group.
- Course schedules may vary from Campus to Campus (Saturday classes are considered in the schedule of some Campuses).

*IETP professors will be assigned a tutor who will be in charge of providing guidance and support during their stay.*

## IETP Responsibilities

### Selected candidates are expected to:

- Accomplish the IETP activities in the given schedule.
- Maintain weekly communication with the assigned tutor.
- Elaborate academic reports and lesson plans.

## Documentation and Application Procedures

### Candidates will be asked to:

- Fill and send the application form (see appendix 1).
- Write and send a brief letter of purpose explaining the reasons and interests for applying to the IET program.
- Provide an official document acknowledging that the candidate is a current and active University Student.
- Obtain and send a reference letter from the University of origin.

*Health insurance with international coverage (Once accepted).*

## Application Deadline

- Documents will be received until June 23th, 2014.
- Candidates will receive an e-mail acknowledging receipt of their application.
