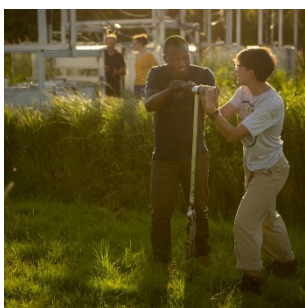


## INTERNATIONAL DEGREE PROGRAMMES AT WEIHENSTEPHAN-TRIESDORF UNIVERSITY OF APPLIED SCIENCES (HSWT)

### 1) INTERNATIONAL MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMMES TAUGHT IN ENGLISH

#### CLIMATE CHANGE MANAGEMENT (M-CCM)



- Duration of studies: 3 semesters (90 ECTS)  
Depending on the entry qualification, acquisition of additional credits might be required, which increases the duration of the course to a total of four semesters (120 ECTS).
- Location of studies: Freising – Weihenstephan (Bavaria, Germany)
- Programme start date: Winter semester (1 October)
- Tuition and semester fees: The degree programme is free of tuition, but all students are required to pay semester fees (approximately € 150 per semester).

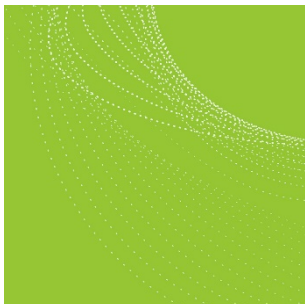
#### INTERNATIONAL MASTER OF LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE (IMLA)



- Duration of studies: 3 semesters (90 ECTS)  
Depending on the entry qualification, acquisition of additional credits might be required, which increases the duration of the course to a total of four semesters (120 ECTS).
- Location of studies: Alternates annually between Freising – Weihenstephan (Bavaria) and Nürtingen (Baden-Wuerttemberg)
- Programme start date: Summer semester (15 March)
- Tuition and semester fees: The IMLA programme is free of tuition for all EU citizens. Non-EU citizens are required to pay a tuition fee of € 750 per semester. Additionally, all students are required to pay semester fees (approximately € 150 per semester).

## FARM MANAGEMENT (MFM)



- Duration of studies: 4 semesters (120 EC), including an internship semester
- Location of studies: Weidenbach – Triesdorf (Bavaria, Germany).
- Programme start date: Winter semester (October)
- Tuition and semester fees: The degree programme is free of tuition, but all students are required to pay semester fees (approximately € 50 per semester).

- Duration of studies: 3 semesters (90 ECTS)

- Programme start date: Summer semester (15 March) or winter semester (October)
- Tuition and semester fees: The degree programme is free of tuition, but all students are required to pay semester fees (approximately € 150 per semester).

### INTERNATIONAL MASTER IN AGRICULTURAL MANAGEMENT (IMA)



- Language of instruction: German
- Duration of studies: 4 semesters (120 EC), including an internship semester
- Location of studies: Weidenbach – Triesdorf (Bavaria, Germany).
- Programme start date: Summer semester (15 March)
- Tuition and semester fees: The degree programme is free of tuition, but all students are required to pay semester fees (approximately € 50 per semester).

### 3) OTHER INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMMES

#### GERMAN-FRENCH DOUBLE DEGREE (HORTICULTURE | LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE | LANDSCAPE CONSTRUCTION AND MANAGEMENT)



- Language of instruction: German / French
- Duration of studies: 10 semesters (the first 6 semesters in Germany, from the 7<sup>th</sup> semester in France)
- Location of studies: Freising – Weihenstephan (Bavaria, Germany) and Agrocampus Ouest - Centre d'Angers (Angers, France)
- Programme start date: Winter semester (1 October)
- Tuition and semester fees: The degree programme is free of tuition, but all students are required to pay semester fees (approximately € 150 per semester in Germany).
- Double qualification: German degree certificate (Horticulture: Bachelor of Science; Landscape Architecture / Landscape Construction and Management: Bachelor of Engineering) and French degree certificate (Ingénieur Grade Master)
