Urbanisation is a global megatrend and one of the biggest challenges of the 21st century. 75% of all natural resources and energy are consumed in urban areas. 80% of all climate-damaging emissions take place there. Brazil and Germany are both characterised as highly urbanised countries and therefore face similar challenges both now and in the future. During their first Intergovernmental Consultations (Brasília 19/20 August 2016), Germany and Brazil therefore agreed to establish a German-Brazilian Partnership on Urbanisation to exchange expertise on sustainable urban development.
